We teach vital reading skills through the acronym VIPERS. These skills will enable your child to understand and enjoy books effectively.

You can support your child at home by asking them a variety of questions about what they have read. There is further information on the school website including example questions.

Maths	<p>In maths, Year 5 will be exploring: place value, the four operations and fractions.</p> <p>Year 6 will be exploring: place value, the four operations, fractions and converting units.</p>
English	<p>Writing: In English, we will be learning to write: a recount linked to Letters From a Lighthouse and an adventure story focusing on The Firework-Markers daughter.</p> <p>Reading: Children are expected to read every day at school and at home. In school, we will be reading a wide variety of age-related texts as a class and using the VIPERS approach. We also have a wide variety of age-related texts which are accessible for children to read or access weekly in our library sessions.</p> <p>Our whole class text this half term is Wonder by R. J. Palacio.</p>
Science	<p>In Science, we will be exploring and investigating properties and changes to materials.</p>
RE	<p>In RE, we will be thinking about what mean if Christians believe God is holy and loving and weather Creation and science conflicting or complementary topics.</p>
PSHE	<p>In PSHE, we will be looking at relationships and valuing differences which links to our class story book.</p>
Geography	<p>In Geography, we will be developing our geographical skills through our Eastern European topic which focuses on: understanding continents, countries and cities; comparing landscapes, climates and places as well as understanding what happened in Chernobyl.</p>
History	<p>In History, we will be developing our historical skills through our Mayan topic which focuses on: the Mayan civilisation; religion and Gods; Maya number system; exploration and discovery; Mayan writing and food.</p>

Art and Design	In Art and Design, we will be exploring how we can create typography through drawing and design, and use our skills to create personal and highly visual maps.
Design and Technology	In Design and Technology, we will be exploring seasonal cooking.
PE	In PE, we will be focusing on Dodgeball and Basketball, Tag Rugby and Handball.
French	In French, children covered a variety of different vocabulary and grammatical skills.
Music	In Music, we will be working on topics such as, The show must go on; compose music with your friends; music for the Harvest Festival; remembrance day music and music for the Christmas production
Computing	In computing, we will be developing our digital literacy through understanding how to stay safe online; developing our coding skills in computer science and developing our information technology skills through spreadsheets.
Forest school	Forest School is a child-centred inspirational learning process that offers opportunities for holistic growth and hands-on experiences in the natural environment. It's creative and can increase a child's confidence as they problem-solve and learn to manage risks.
