Maths	Year 3- Length and perimeter, statistics, fractions and money Year 4- Length and perimeter, statistics, fractions and money
English	Writing: In English, we will be learning to write: a narrative based around George's Marvellous Medicine by Roald Dahl. Our own poetry themed called the Colour Collector (based on The Sound Collector by Roger McGough) A balanced argument about whether we should feed animals at National Parks and letters based upon The Gardener by Sarah Stewart Children are expected to read every day at school and at home. In school, we will be reading a wide variety of age-related texts as a class and using the VIPERS approach. We also carry out partner reader, popcorn reading- the book is shared around the class and echo read which teaches us how to intonate. We have a wide variety of age-related texts which are accessibly for children to read or access weekly in our library sessions. Our whole class text this term will be Anglo Saxon Boy- by Tony Bradman
Science	In Science, we will be learning about skeletons, teeth the digestive system and living things and habitats
RE	In RE, we will be learning about the deeper meanings of festivals and why people try to make the world a better place focusing upon Muslims, Jewish people, Hindus, Sikhs, Christians non-religious celebrations.
PSHE	In PSHE, we will be focusing upon being our best
Geography	In Geography, we will be developing our geographical skills through a detailed study of the UK
History	In History, we will be developing our historical skills through the Anglo Saxons and Scots

Art and Design	In Art and Design, we will be exploring the artist Lucia Hierro combining observational drawing and sculpture.
Design and Technology	In Design and Technology, we will be growing our own fruit and vegetables and using these within our cooking.
PE	In PE, we will be focusing on orienteering and Tennis.
Music	In Music, we will be working on the structure of songs, focusing upon and developing our digital music skills alongside learning songs for the summer production.
Computing	In Computing, we will be developing our touch typing and learning about emails.
