We teach vital reading skills through the acronym VIPERS. These skills will enable your child to understand and enjoy books effectively.

You can support your child at home by asking them a variety of questions about what they have read. There is further information on the school website including example questions.

Maths	<p>In Maths, Year 5 will be exploring: shape, position and direction, decimals, negative numbers, converting units and volume.</p> <p>Year 6 will be exploring: shape, position and direction, themed projects, consolidation and problem solving.</p>
English	<p>Writing:</p> <p>In English, we will be learning to write: a romance story based on The Paperman; a narrative poem based on Hope-o-potamus; a poem rap based on My Puppy Poet and Me and a balanced argument focusing on screentime.</p> <p>Reading:</p> <p>Children are expected to read every day at school and at home. In school, we will be reading a wide variety of age-related texts as a class and using the VIPERS approach. We also have a wide variety of age-related texts which are accessible for children to read or access weekly in our library sessions.</p>
Science	<p>In Science, we will be exploring and investigating evolution and inheritance and living things and their habitats.</p>
RE	<p>In RE, we will be thinking about How do Christians decide how to live? 'What would Jesus do? We will also be thinking about how and why do some people inspire others?</p>
PSHE	<p>In PSHE, we will be focusing on being our best and growing and changing.</p>
Geography	<p>In Geography, we will be developing our geographical skills through understanding and using mapping skills.</p>
History	<p>In History, we will be developing our historical skills through our Ancient Greek topic.</p>

Art and Design	In Art and Design, we will be creating a model set for theatre or animation inspired by poetry, prose, film or music.
Design and Technology	In Design and Technology, we will be creating marbulous structures.
PE	In PE, we will be focusing on cricket, OAA, swimming and athletics.
French	In the theme of 'les vacances ' pupils will be learning vocabulary for clothes. They will also recap colours, position, agreement of adjectives whilst also recapping weather and countries.
Music	In Music, we will be working on topics such as, to learn to play the p trumpet, Don't stop believing unit and music for the end of year production.
Computing	In Computing, we will be developing our information technology skills through game creating.
Forest school	Forest School is a child-centred inspirational learning process that offers opportunities for holistic growth and hands-on experiences in the natural environment. It's creative and can increase a child's confidence as they problem-solve and learn to manage risks.
