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| Maths     | In maths, we will be exploring:<br><b>Multiplication and division</b><br><b>Area, Perimeter and Volume</b><br><b>Fractions, Decimals and Percentage</b>  |
| English   | Writing:<br>In English, we will be learning to write: a traditional tale, a biography and a non-chronological report.<br><br>Reading:<br>Children are expected to read every day at school and at home. In school, we will be reading a wide variety of age-related texts as a class and using the VIPERS approach. We also have a wide variety of age-related texts which are accessible for children to read or access weekly in our library sessions.<br><br>Our whole class texts this half term are:<br>A medal for Leroy<br>Novel by Michael Morpurgo<br><br>Rivet Boy<br>Novel by Barbara Henderson |
| Science   | In Science, we will be exploring and investigating electricity and animals including humans.   |
| RE        | In RE, we will be thinking about justice and poverty and what makes our community a respectful place.  |
| PSHE      | In PSHE, we will be looking at how to keep safe and our rights and respect.  |
| Geography | In Geography, we will be developing our geographical skills through our North America topic.   |
| History   | In History, we will be developing our historical skills through our World War Two topic.   |

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| Art and Design        | In Art and Design, we will be exploring painting and mixed media: artist study  |
| Design and Technology | In Design and Technology, we will be exploring Cooking and nutrition.   |
| PE                    | In PE, we will be focusing on developing skills in Gymnastics, Basketball and Cricket.  |
| French                | In French, the children will cover a variety of different vocabulary and grammatical skills.  |
| Music                 | In Music, we will be learning the P trumpet and preparing for our Easter Assembly.  |
| Computing             | In computing, we will be exploring blogging and text adventures.  |
| Forest school         | Forest School is a child-centred inspirational learning process that offers opportunities for holistic growth and hands-on experiences in the natural environment. It's creative and can increase a child's confidence as they problem-solve and learn to manage risks. |
